STATE DOES NOT OWE PASTOR MARGARET WANJIRU SPECIAL TREATMENT

It has been reported that a section of the Jesus Is Alive Ministries Building, a church belonging to Pastor Margaret Wanjiru, has been demolished by government operatives. Pastor Wanjiru has accused the government of acting irresponsibly, and stated that the government should not demolish places of worship.

We wish to clarify that the State does not owe any special treatment to Pastor Wanjiru solely because of her position as a religious leader. The Kenyan Constitution mandates that the religious majority should not receive preferential treatment. If Pastor Wanjiru has violated any laws, the legal process should proceed as normal.
